Income compensation allowance

Military service – civilian service – civil protection (service) – Youth and Sport instructor courses

The basic allowance is 80 % of average income received prior to service.
Supplementary benefits are available to cover care and operating expenses.

Maternity allowance

Federal allowances (only maternity)

The basic allowance is 80 % of average income received before delivery.

The maximum allowance is CHF 220.- per day, for 98 days.

Canton of Geneva allowances (maternity and adoption)

The basic allowance is 80 % of average income received before delivery.

The maximum allowance is CHF 329.60 per day, for 112 days.

In case of motherhood, the Geneva allowances compensate the Federal allowances.

In case of adoption, the allowances are paid to the mother or the father.

Allowance for the other parent (father or mother's wife)

The base allowance corresponds to 80% of the average income earned before the birth of the child.

The maximum amount of the allowance is CHF 220.- per day.

Within 6 months after the birth, the leave is taken per day (after 5 days, 2 additional paid days) or per week (5 working days + 2 additional paid days), or a combination of the two. *In any event, no more than 10 working days will be taken as leave and two times 2 additional paid days.*
